You will be given 12 definitions and asked to match them with 10 medical terms.

SECTION TWO: POLITICAL MATCHING

10 QUESTIONS, 1 PT EA - 10 PTS

You will be given 12 definitions and asked to match them with 10 political terms.

SECTION THREE: LATIN PHRASES

5 QUESTIONS, 2 PTS EA - 10 PTS

You will be asked to complete a sentence using a Latin legal phrase from a word bank (only the phrases specified in class will be tested).

Ex.

<i>sine qua non</i>	<i>de jure</i>	<i>caveat emptor</i>
---------------------	----------------	----------------------

You must break the underlined medical terms below into their components and define the meaning of each part. Then, using your breakdown of the word AND the context which the sentence provides, select the best dictionary definition of each from the four provided choices.

Ex.

Julius went to the doctor the other day with an ear infection; the doctor used an otoscope to examine him.

Component and its meaning: ot, ear

Component and its meaning: scope, device for seeing

Best definition:

- a) A self-seeing device
- b) A device used to see inside the ear canal
- c) A scope that you *ought* to use
- d) A device which measures your heart-rate

SECTION FIVE: POLITICAL ANALYZE AND DEFINE

6 QUESTIONS, 3 PTS EA - 18 PTS

You must break the underlined political terms below into their components and define the meaning of each part. Then, using your breakdown of the word AND the context which the sentence provides, select the best dictionary definition of each from the four provided choices. (Note that some political words will only have one base)

Ex.

Some critics of president Obama say that he manipulates the people using emotions in the way of a demagogue.

Component and its meaning: demo, relating to the people

Component and its meaning: ago, to lead

Best definition:

- a) The place of worship for those of the Jewish faith
- b) A cautious and soft-spoken politician
- c) A politician who comes to power by taking advantage of the feelings of the voters
- d) Another word for demi-god

SECTION SIX: HISTORY!

Ex.

Who was Draco?
